

The space has been fully renewed within the existing structure. The site is complimented by soft landscaping and additional cycle parking.








FLOOR **PLANS**





LOCAL AREA

Cambridge is a city on the River Cam, home to the prestigious University of Cambridge, dating from 1209. University colleges include King's, famed for its choir and towering Gothic chapel, as well as Trinity, founded by Henry VIII, and St John's, with its 16th-century Great Gate.

The hi-tech and biotechnology industries are central to the local economy. Cambridge technologies are leading the way in fields such as semiconductors, wireless technology, display technology, sensors, inkjet technology, mobile telecommunications and instrumentation.

Cambridge is already home to Europe's foremost biotechnology cluster and also companies that are leading the research in drug discovery, development and delivery, agricultural biotechnology and animal healthcare.




TRAVEL & TRANSPORT

Cambridge Science Park is easily accessed from Junction 33 of the A14. Closely connected to the M11, the Park has good transport links with Stansted Airport and London. Cambridge North Railway Station can be accessed within minutes via the guided bus stop which passes through the Park, providing rail connections to London King's Cross and Liverpool Street.

SUSTAINABLE TRAVEL CHOICES

Free electric pool bikes for hire allow employees to make quick visits around the area or into Cambridge city centre.

Cambridge Science Park operates in a Travel Plan Plus (TP+) Area. This offers employers an extensive range of professional services, tools and resources. The scheme promotes sustainable travel choices and commuting behaviour, helping to save time, money and improve staff health and wellbeing.



"The Busway" – a guided bus network has two stops at the Park, which also connects Cambridge town centre with Huntingdon and St Ives.
