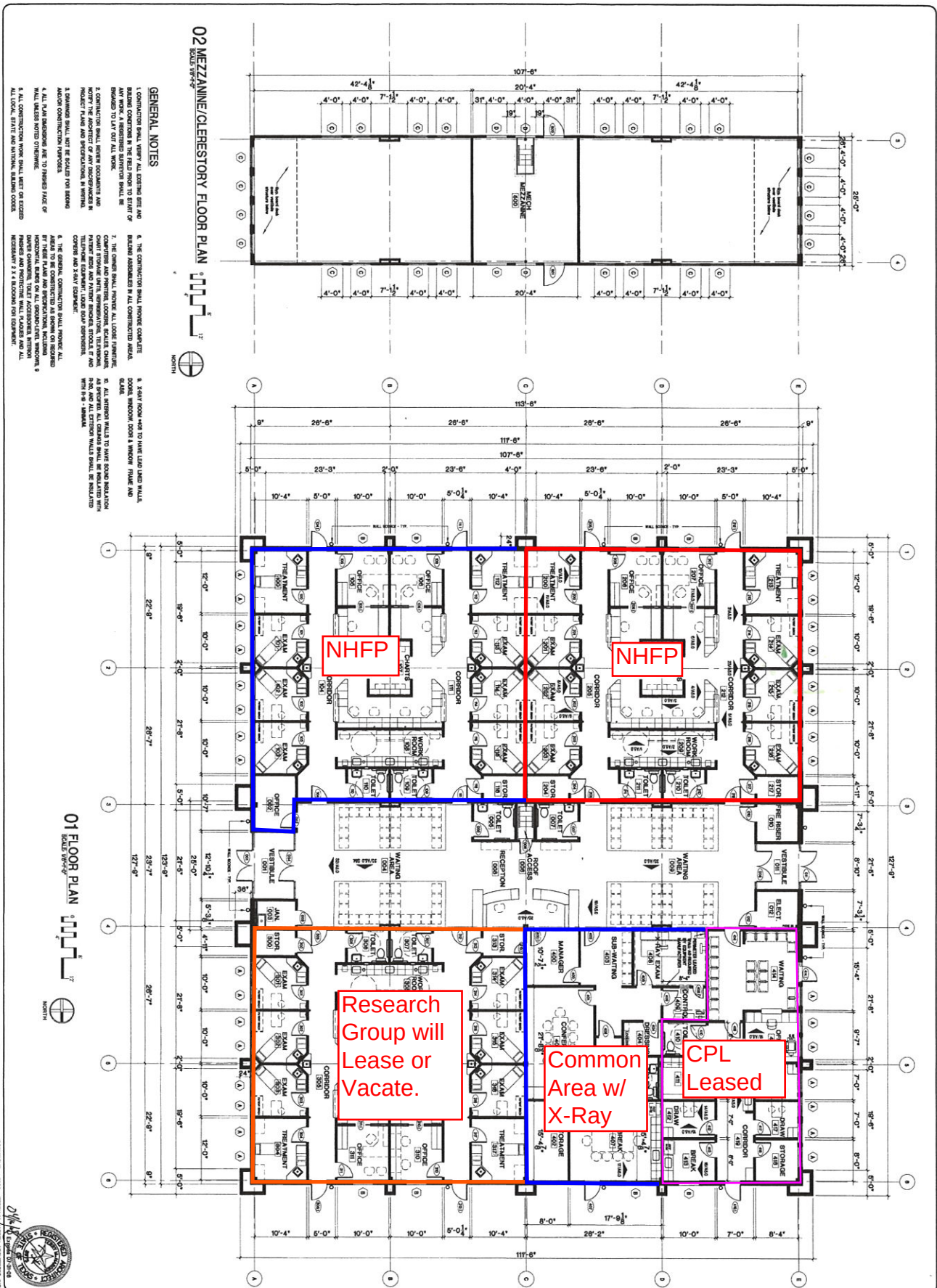




GENERAL NOTES

1. CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL EXISTING SITE AND BUILDING CONDITIONS IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO START OF CONSTRUCTION. ANY DISCREPANCIES SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE ARCHITECT IMMEDIATELY.
2. THE OWNER SHALL PROVIDE ALL LOGS, PERMITS, CERTIFICATES AND PLANS, INCLUDING EXISTING, CONVEYANCE, PLAT, AND PLAT RECORDS, TO THE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO START OF CONSTRUCTION.
3. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ALL NECESSARY PERMITS AND APPROVALS FROM ALL LOCAL, STATE AND NATIONAL AGENCIES.
4. ALL PLANS SHOWN ARE TO REMAIN IN PLACE OF EXISTING CONDITIONS UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE.
5. ALL CONSTRUCTION WORK SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL LOCAL, STATE AND NATIONAL BUILDING CODES.
6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ACCESS TO ALL EXISTING UTILITIES AND STRUCTURES. ANY DISCREPANCIES SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE ARCHITECT IMMEDIATELY.
7. THE OWNER SHALL PROVIDE ALL LOGS, PERMITS, CERTIFICATES AND PLANS, INCLUDING EXISTING, CONVEYANCE, PLAT, AND PLAT RECORDS, TO THE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO START OF CONSTRUCTION.
8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ALL NECESSARY PERMITS AND APPROVALS FROM ALL LOCAL, STATE AND NATIONAL AGENCIES.
