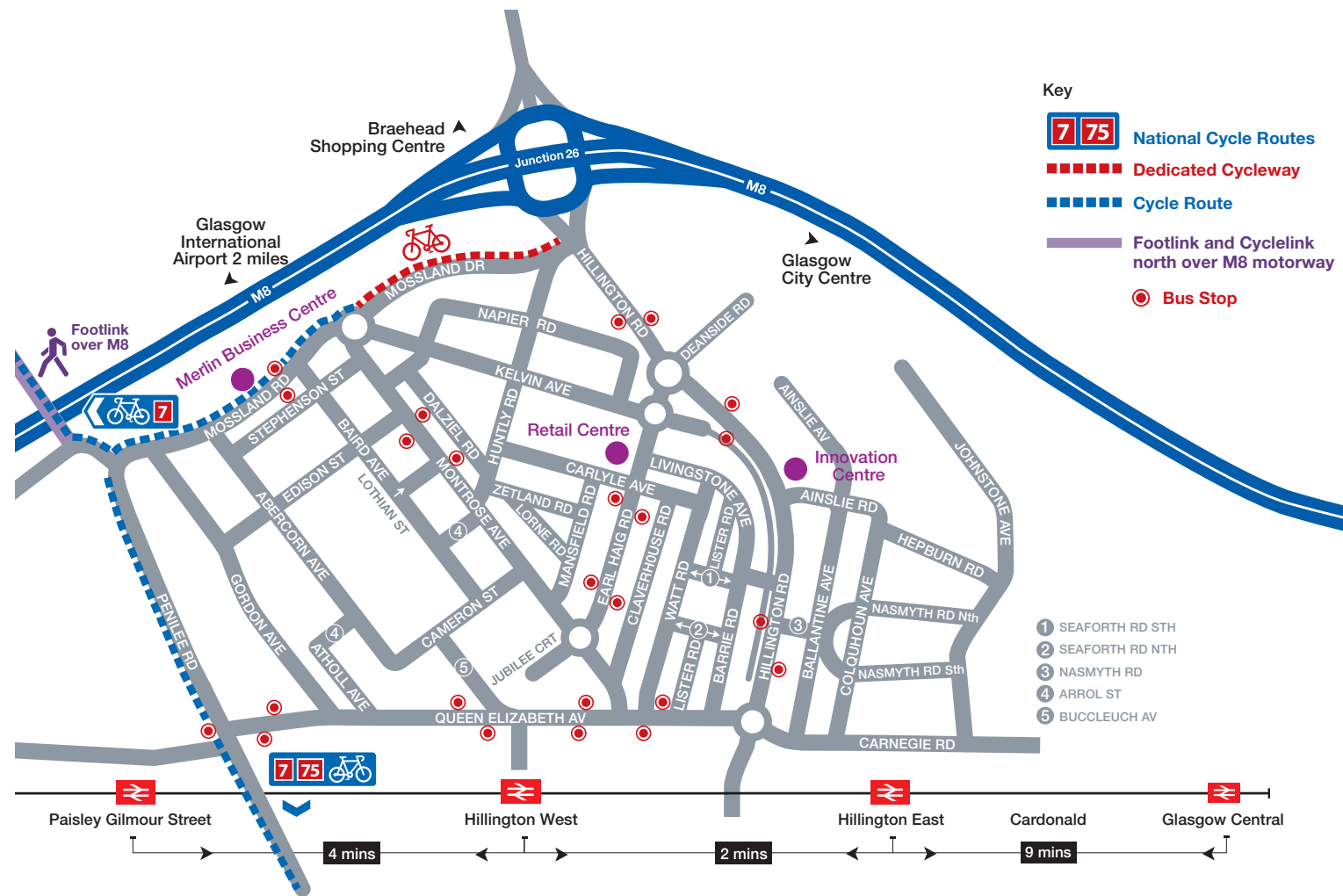

**Hillington Park** is an easy commute for staff and highly accessible for visitors. Located at junction 26 of the M8, next door to Glasgow International Airport, and with two train stations and nine bus routes on the Park itself, Hillington Park is a great location for businesses.



## Car

Hillington Park is at junction 26 of the M8 motorway between Glasgow city to the east and the towns of Paisley and Renfrew to the west. The location is well served by the M8, M74 and M77 motorway networks and interconnecting arterial routes. The A736 runs through the centre of the Park and connects the A8 north and A761 south.

## Bus

There are nine bus routes running through the Park, there is a bus transport hub and travel information centre located at the nearby Braehead shopping centre. 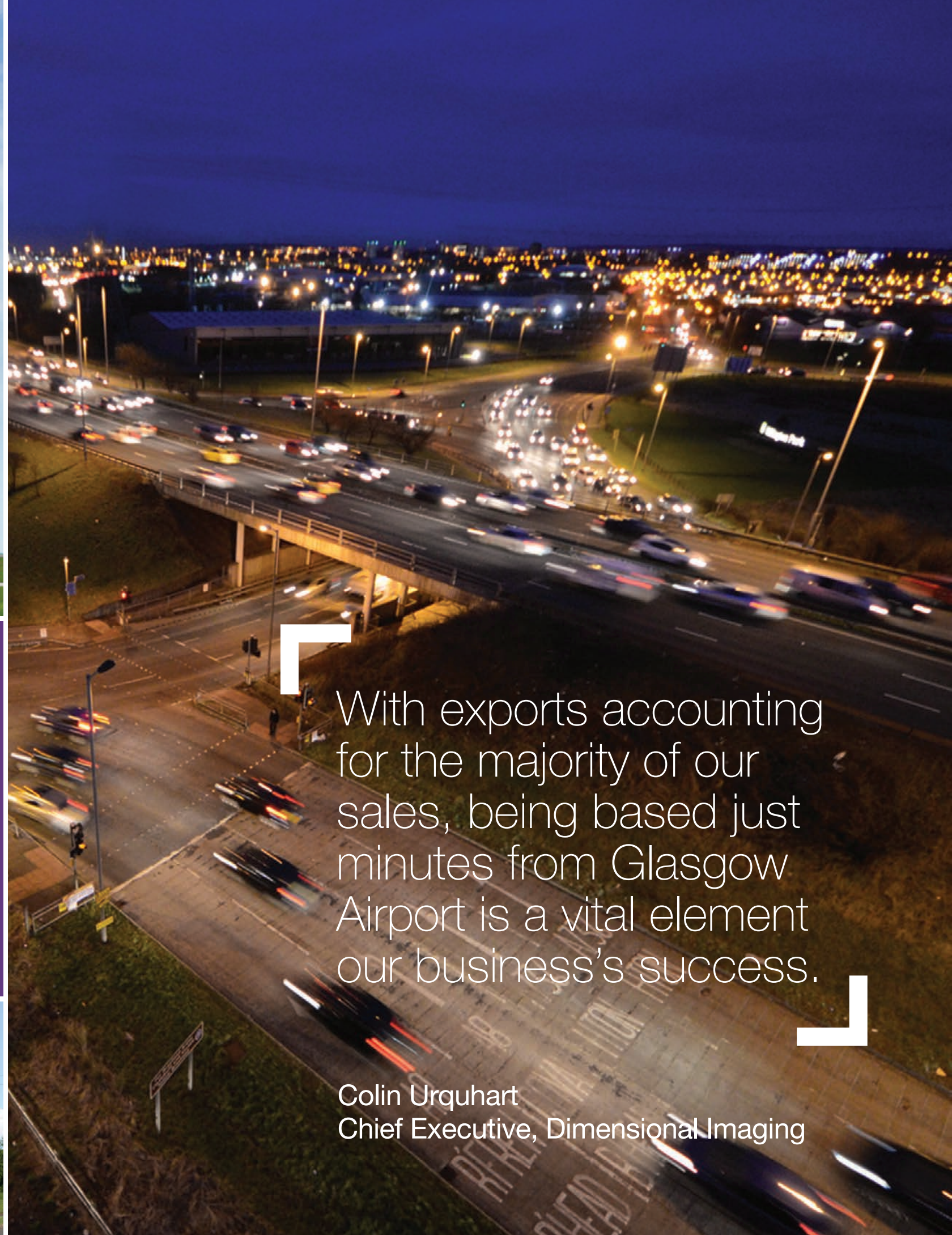


## Walking

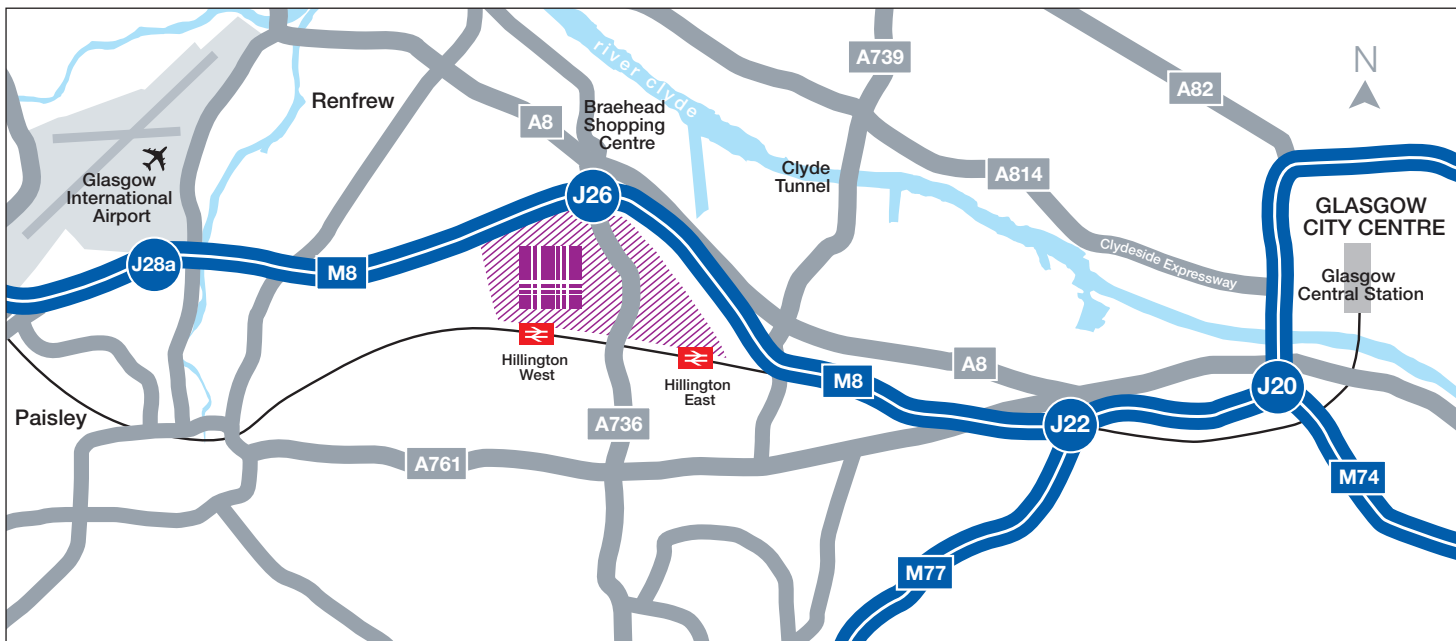

Scotland's first Simplified Planning Zone



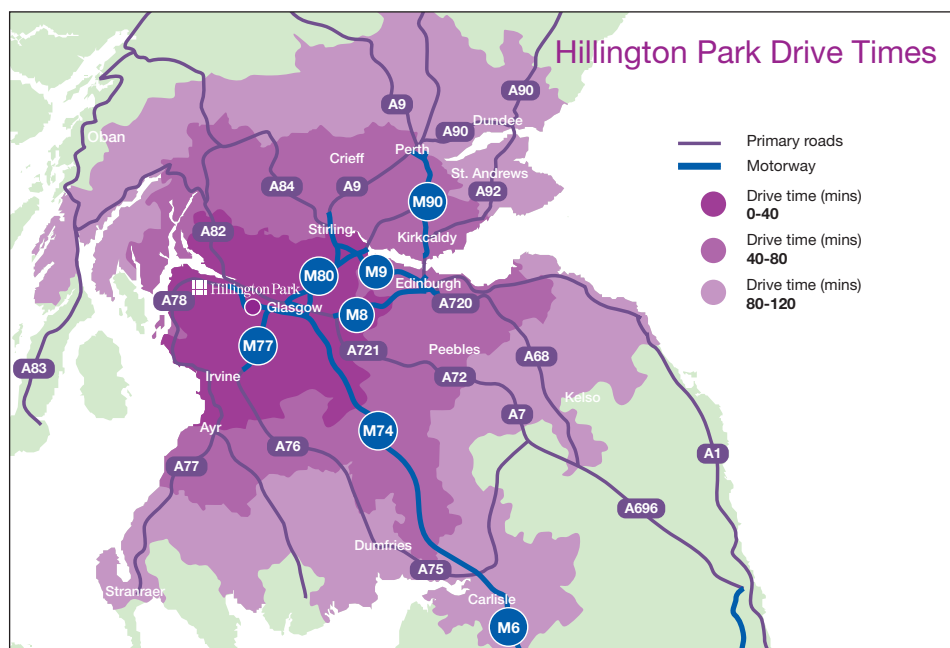




Hillington Park is at Junction 26 of the M8 motorway between Glasgow City to the east and the towns of Paisley and Renfrew to the west.
