Dear Ms. Fliegel:

The letter is to confirm existing public water and sewer service (from 1968 and 1977, respectively) for your property located at 14100 Travilah Road, Rockville, as verified by the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC). Although the Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) sewer category maps show this property as sewer category S-6, for properties planned to use an onsite septic system, WSSC's verification of public sewer service is sufficient to warrant a correction from category S-6 to S-1. Category S-1 identifies properties approved for public sewer service and with service available. The existing W-1 water category for the property is correct.

DEP has formalized the category correction process for cases that change service area categories from those used for private, onsite systems to those for public service. DEP will include this correction in the next administrative correction action later this summer. We will notify you when this action is completed. Pending that correction action, the property and any development thereon continues to be eligible for public water and sewer service from WSSC.
