



Seacrest Village Condo

In general all the trees and ornamental shrubs need to be pruned this fall. Some require removal while others need to be transplanted and relocated.

Broken down by each property:

Entry: Remove Leyland cypress, transplant one small Juniper.

\$1,600.00 Prune all trees/plants as needed.

1 John Gilpin: Remove two spruce, including roots and repair of lawn

\$3,200.00 Prune Leyland cypress

General pruning

10 Seacrest: Leyland Hedge by street pruned to height

\$3,200.00 White Pine

General pruning

14 Seacrest: White pine pruned

\$3,200.00 General Pruning

15 Seacrest: Remove Leyland

\$3,200.00 Replace with Green giant

Plus Arborvitae General pruning

18 Seacrest: Prune Arborvitae

\$2,500.00 General Pruning

19 Seacrest: Move 2 Emerald greens to fill spaces

\$2,500.00 General Pruning

20 Seacrest: Prune as needed

\$1,900.00 Birches pruned

23 Seacrest: Remove Cherry

\$3,300.00 Remove Spruce

Plus 1 Emerald Prune White pine

Green Arborvitae Plant 1 Emerald green

Move 2 Hydrangeas

24 Seacrest: Remove dead White pines

\$3,200.00 Prune remaining White pines

General Pruning

Kill Knotweed

28 Seacrest: Move 2 rose of Sharon

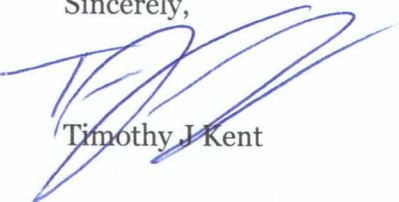
\$2,500.00 General Pruning
