1FA - What's Included



Design, fit-out, furniture

- → Private meeting rooms, phone booths, breakout areas
- → Workstation furniture, including desk and task chairs
- → Sit stand workstation desks
- → Employee lockers (equivalent to one per person)
- → Private kitchenette and tea point



Shared meeting rooms

- → 6 x 10 person, 1 x 54 person, 1 x 16 person
- → Phone booths, breakout areas and alternative work settings
- → 1 x well-being room
- → 4 x shared tea points
- → Allowance of room credits
- → Ease of booking via the online portal

Storey Club access

→ Exclusive access to Storey Club (located at Paddington – lounge, meeting and event venue)



Staff support

- → Dedicated community manager, for all your needs
- → Storey relationship manager to work with you as your business progresses



Connectivity, technology & bookings

- → Book private and shared meeting rooms, Storey Club rooms and visitor access via the online portal
- → Private share of 10GB primary line and 10GB secondary line for resilience
- → Private and secure WiFi/VLAN per customer
- → 1 data point per desk for wired connection to VLAN



Utilities / property costs / insurance

- → All utilities included in the cost (Monday to Friday – excluding Bank Holidays)
- → Rent, rates, service charge all managed
- → Building, public liability and contents insurance for supplied furniture and fittings included



Recycling

- → Dry waste recycling
- → Separated food waste



Maintenance & cleaning

- → Full cleaning provision of both shared space and private offices
- → All maintenance and repairs to mechanical and electrical on floor equipment and building fabric



Health and safety

- → General and fire risk assessments (typically annually)
- → First aid trained security on-site
- → Fire warden training (typically annually)
- → Pest control preventative monthly visits and 24 hour call out



Access to building facilities

- → Bikes, shower and lockers
- → Café and seating area
- → 3,000 sq ft roof terrace
