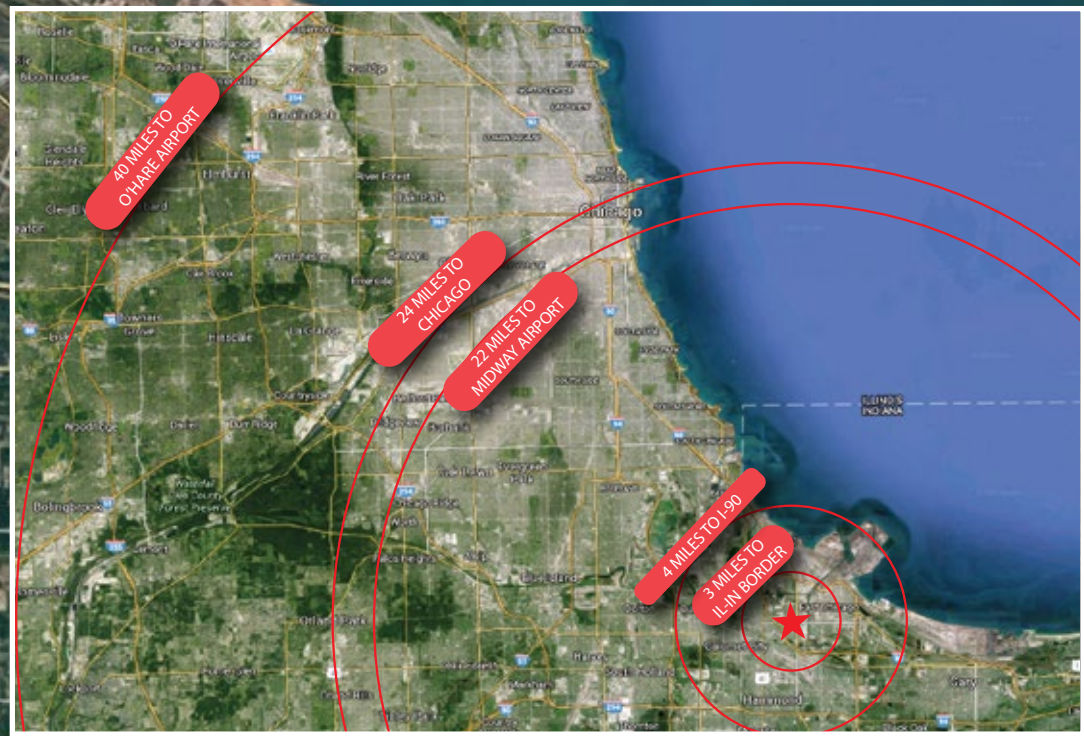

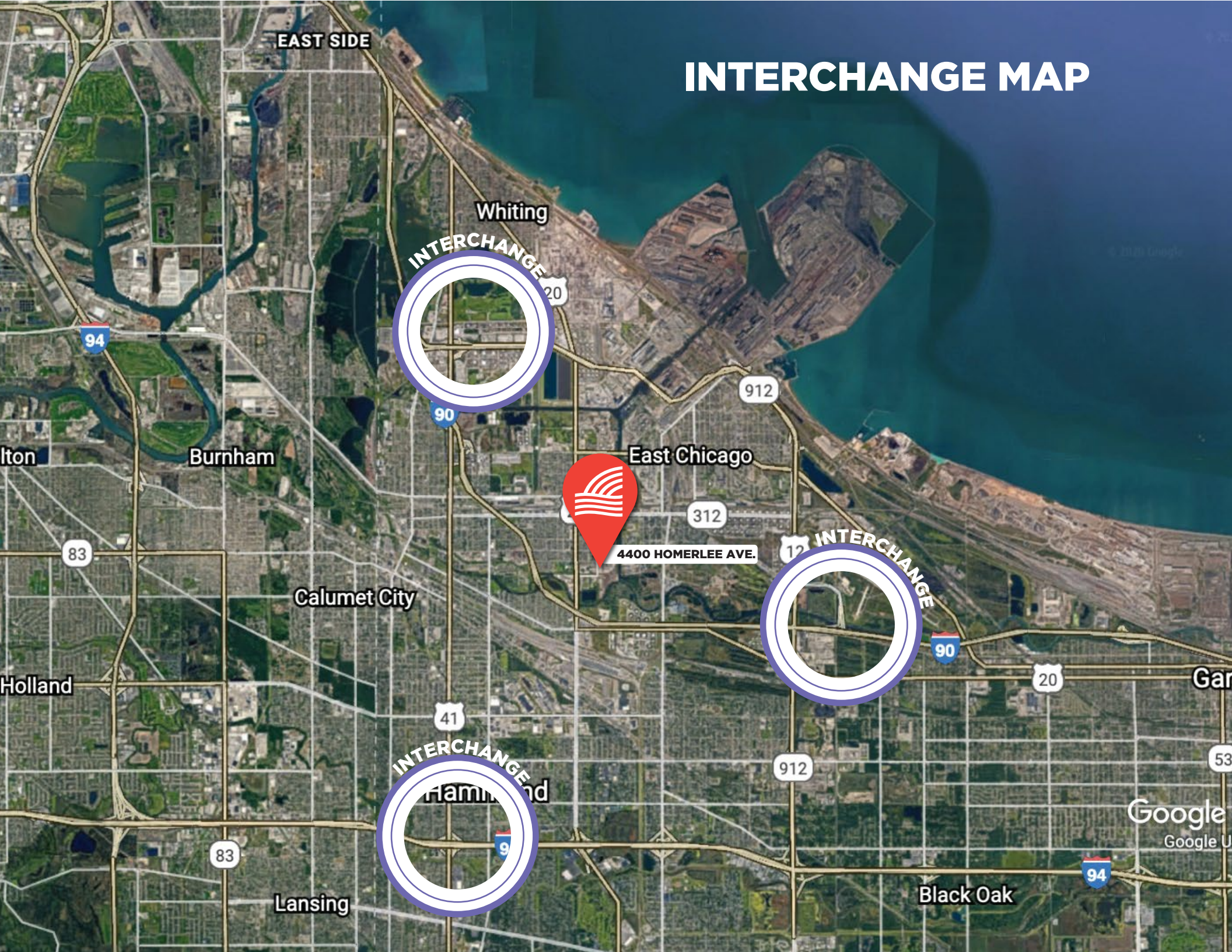
DISTANCE MAPS

LATEST MARKET DATA FIGURES WERE RELEASED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT FOR FEBRUARY 2019 AND REFLECT CHANGES SINCE DECEMBER 2018.

The latest data for Northwest Indiana (February 2019) shows that our region has continued to grow its workforce. The Northwest Indiana labor force has grown by 1,290 since January, and over 7,000, or 2 percent, since the same time one year ago.

Digging deeper into these numbers brings even more good news for the region. The increases in employment account for the vast majority of the changes in the month-over-month and year-over-year labor force changes, representing 67 percent and 81 percent respectively. This means that many of Northwest Indiana's new labor market entrants are finding work.

Looking more closely at industry employment, local government educational services experienced the largest gain from the previous month, adding 1,200 jobs. However, as compared to the previous year, the industry experienced growth of 100 jobs, or less than a 1 percent increase. Construction employment, while a loss of 200 jobs since January, has experienced the largest change from the previous year, increasing 11 percent, or 1,600 jobs.

The retail industry saw the largest decline from the previous month, losing 600 jobs or 1.6 percent. This change nearly matches the year-over-year change of -500.

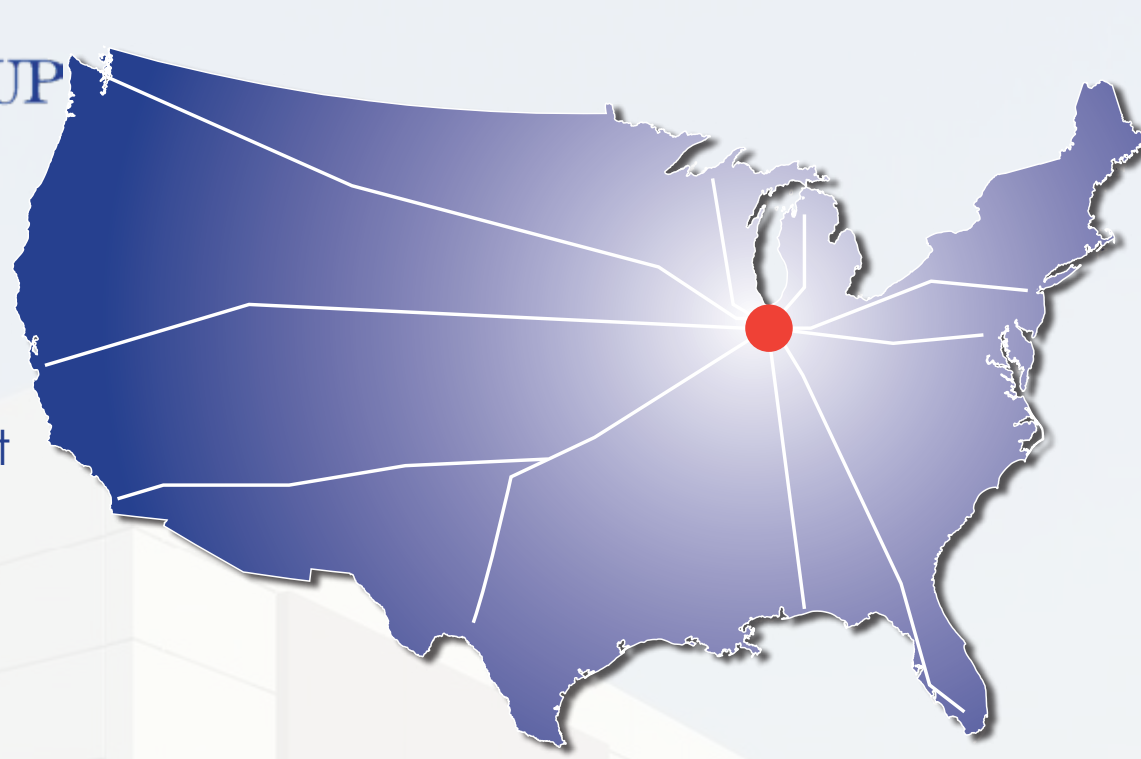

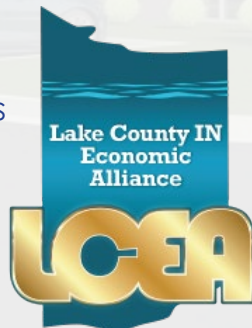
Lake County Economic Development Alliance (LCEA)

All major surface routes between the east coast and Chicago (the nation's rail hub) pass through Northwest Indiana. Lake County, Indiana is less than one hour from Chicago, two from Indianapolis and Milwaukee and four to five hours drive to Detroit, Cleveland and St. Louis. Chicago's O'Hare and Midway Airports are within an hour's drive. The South Shore and Metra provide a valuable option for rail travel to and from Chicago.

DEEP WATER PORT

The Port of Indiana is close by in Portage, Indiana. It connects Indiana to the world via the St. Lawrence Seaway and handles more ocean-going cargo than any other U.S. Great Lakes port and 15 percent of the U.S. steel trade with Europe. It handles half a million trucks, 10,000 rail-cars, 400 barges, and 100 ships per year.



GARY/CHICAGO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Gary/Chicago is the official "third airport" for the Chicago area, supplementing Chicago's major airports, O'Hare and Midway. Gary/Chicago Airport has been designed with an eye towards growth, and the administration is courting airlines aggressively. Numerous businesses including Boeing, Menards and White Lodging Services, base their corporate aircraft here. A National Guard installation has also been built.
