EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Boulder Group is pleased to exclusively market for sale a single tenant net leased Walgreens located within the Milwaukee MSA in Racine, Wisconsin. The lease is absolute triple net and features zero landlord responsibilities. There are approximately 10 years remaining in the primary term of the lease. Walgreens has successfully operated at this location since 2003 where they have significantly above average store sales, drive-thru pharmacy and an established customer base.

The 15,120 square foot Walgreens benefits from its hard corner location along Durand Ave (21,100 VPD), which is a primary east-west thoroughfare in Racine. Retailers in the immediate area include Target, Ross Dress for Less, Pick 'n Save, Best Buy, Dick's Sporting Goods, Home Depot, Walmart Supercenter and Menards. The property is also near Regency Mall. Regency Mall is an enclosed super-regional shopping mall featuring 110 retail spaces and is anchored by Burlington Coat Factory and Bob's Discount Furniture. Regency Mall is the fifth-largest shopping center in the Milwaukee region and is currently undergoing a \$7.5 million renovation. In 2018, Foxconn Technology Group, the world's largest computer electronics manufacturer and a major supplier for Apple Inc., announced it would bring a \$10 billion manufacturing complex in Racine County. Foxconn and government officials have said will be a 22-million-square-foot campus employing as many as 13,000 people. This will bring positive momentum and drive future traffic to the trade corridor.

The Walgreens lease expires September 30, 2028 and features ten 5-year renewal option periods. Walgreens is the largest drug retailing chain in the United States and has over 8,175 locations in the U.S.A. Walgreens is publicly traded on the New York Stock Exchange (WBA) with a market capitalization in excess of \$73 billion. Both Walgreen Co. and Walgreens Boots Alliance, Inc. are investment grade rated each with a Standard & Poor's rating of BBB.













MARKET OVERVIEW:

Racine, Wisconsin

Racine is a city in and the county seat of Racine County, Wisconsin, United States. It is located on the shore of Lake Michigan at the mouth of the Root River. Racine is located 22 miles south of Milwaukee. As of the 2010 U.S. census, the city had a population of 78,860, making it the fifth-largest city in Wisconsin. Its median home price of \$103,625 makes it one of the most affordable cities in Wisconsin to buy a home. In January 2017, it was rated "the most affordable place to live in the world" by the Demographia International Housing Affordability survey.



Racine is the headquarters of a number of industries, including J. I. Case (heavy equipment), S. C. Johnson & Son (cleaning and chemical products), Dremel Corporation, Reliance Controls Corporation (time controls and transfer switches), Twin Disc, and Arthur B. Modine (Heat Exchangers). The Mitchell & Lewis Company, a wagonmaker in the 19th century, began making motorcycles and automobiles as Mitchell-Lewis Motor Company at the start of the 20th century. Racine is also home to InSinkErator, the first garbage disposal.

In 2018, Foxconn Technology Group, the world's largest computer electronics manufacturer and a major supplier for Apple Inc., announced it would bring a \$10 billion manufacturing complex in Racine County. Foxconn and government officials have said will be a 22-million-square-foot campus employing as many as 13,000 people.

Milwaukee is the largest city in Wisconsin and the 28th most populous city in the United States. Milwaukee is located on the southwestern shore of Lake Michigan. According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the City of Milwaukee had a population of 594,833 and the Milwaukee MSA had a population of 1,751,316.

Walgreens

Walgreens Boots Alliance, Inc. operates as a pharmacy-led health and wellbeing company. The company operates through three segments: Retail Pharmacy USA, Retail Pharmacy International, and Pharmaceutical Wholesale. The Retail Pharmacy USA segment sells prescription drugs and an assortment of general merchandise, including non-prescription drugs, beauty products, photo finishing, seasonal merchandise, greeting cards, and convenience foods through its retail drugstores and convenient care clinics. It also provides specialty pharmacy services; and manages in-store clinics under the brand Healthcare Clinic. As of January 31, 2017, this segment operated 8,175 retail stores under the Walgreens and Duane Reade brands in the United States; and 7 specialty pharmacy locations, as well as managed approximately 400 Healthcare Clinics. Walgreens Boots Alliance, Inc. was founded in 1901 and is based in Deerfield, Illinois.

The Walgreen Company is the largest drug retailing chain in the United States. The company is publicly traded on the NASDAQ (Symbol: WBA) with a market capitalization in excess of \$73 billion. Both Walgreen Co. and Walgreens Boots Alliance, Inc. are investment grade rated each with a Standard & Poor's rating of BBB. In October 2016 Walgreens Boots Alliance received the United Nations Foundation Global Leadership Award for its commitment to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals.
