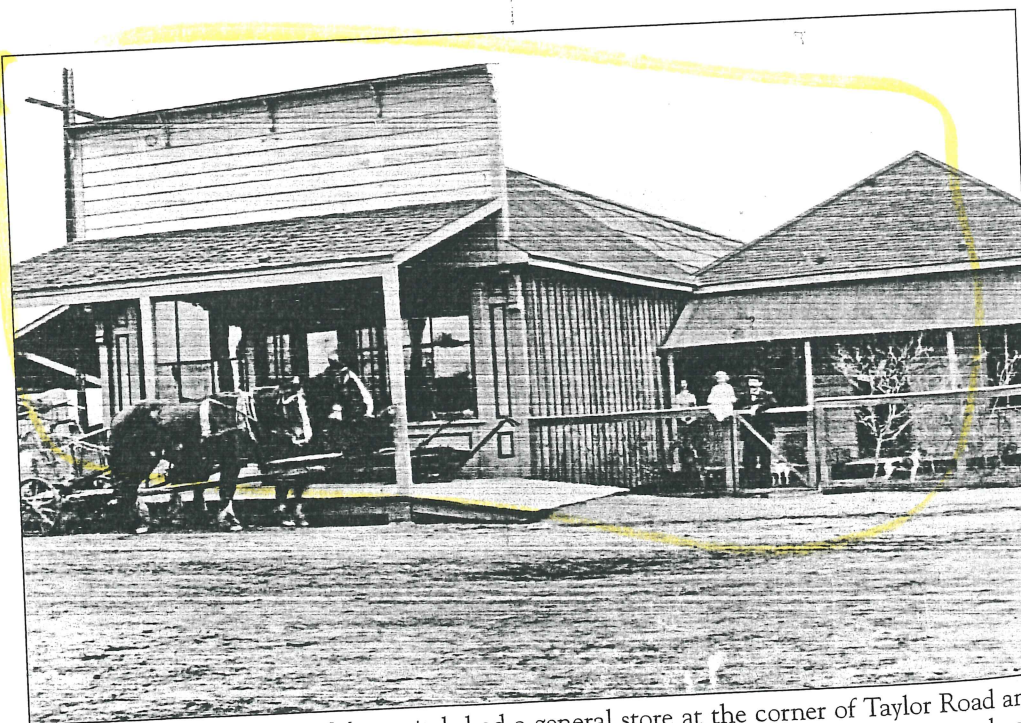




This shows the Law Brothers store prior to September 24, 1939, before fire struck the store. The right-hand section of the rebuilt store eventually became the building that housed the Bank of America. Law Brothers eventually sold and repaired televisions and small appliances.



In the early 1900s, George Moscovitch had a general store at the corner of Taylor Road and Walnut Street. On the right is the Ford home. Later this location became Law Brothers, and now it is the site of the Christensen's Saddle and Supply store.
