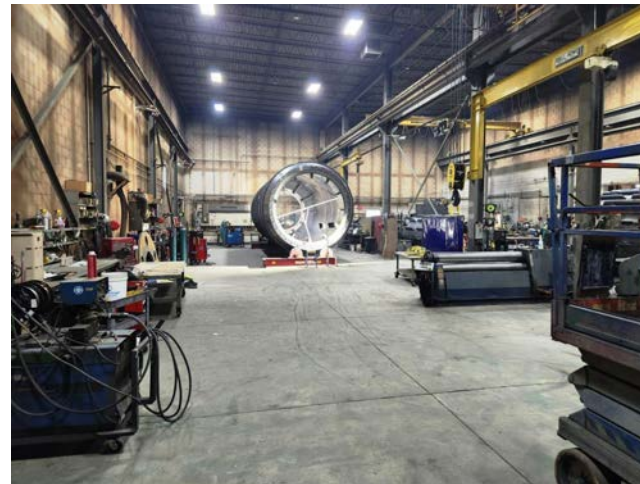

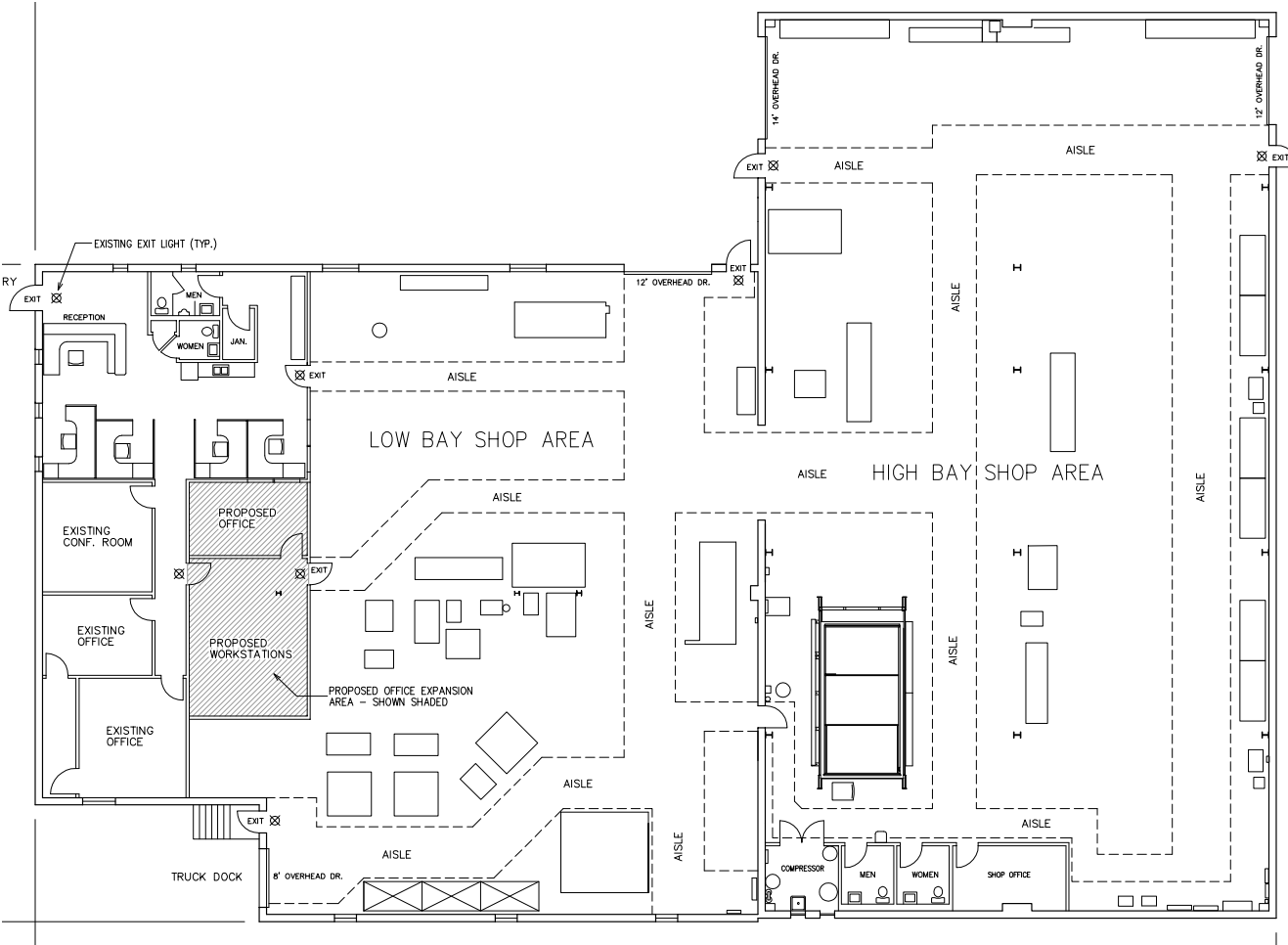

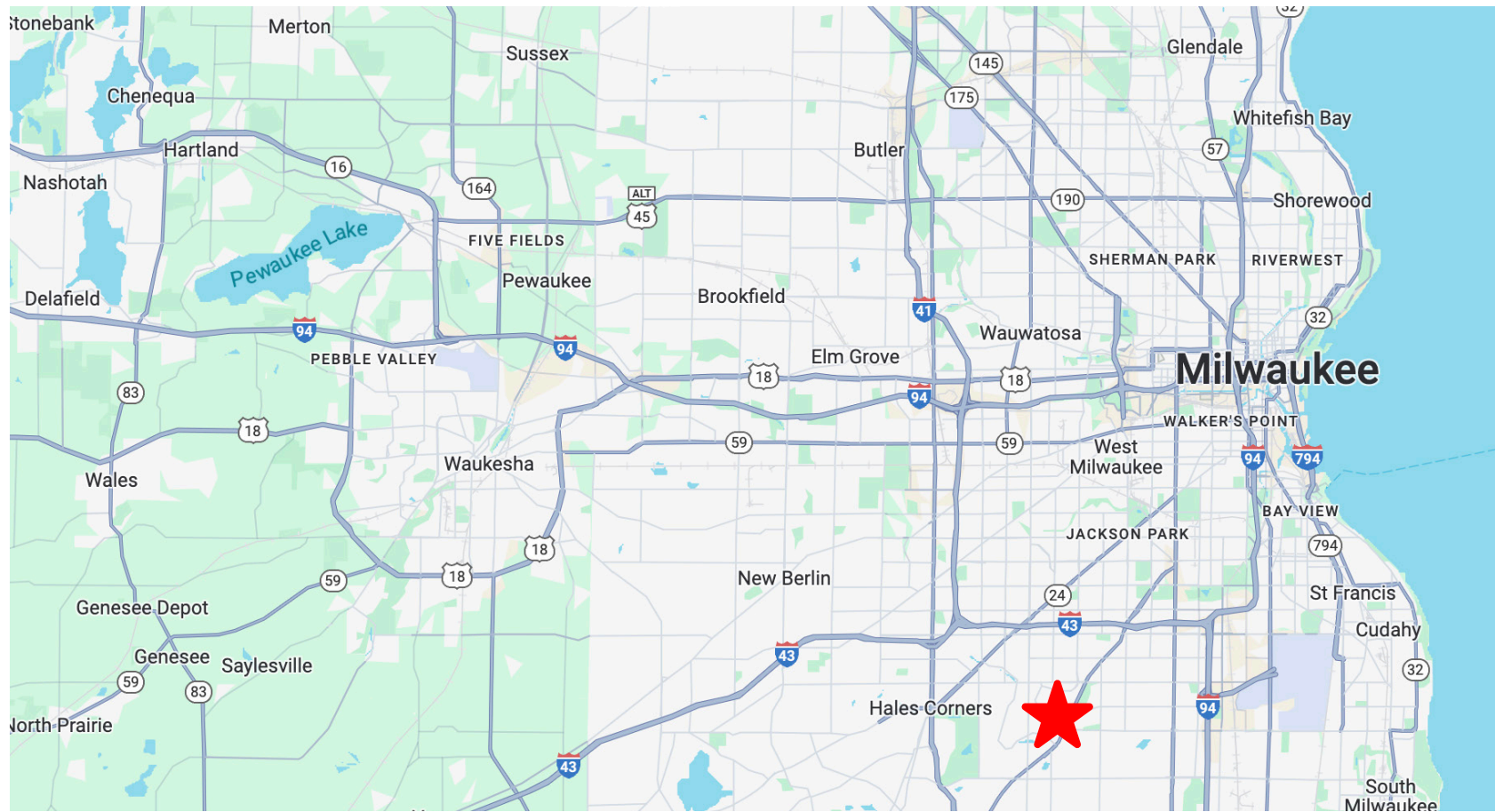


FLOOR PLAN

Disclosure to Non-Resident Customers
