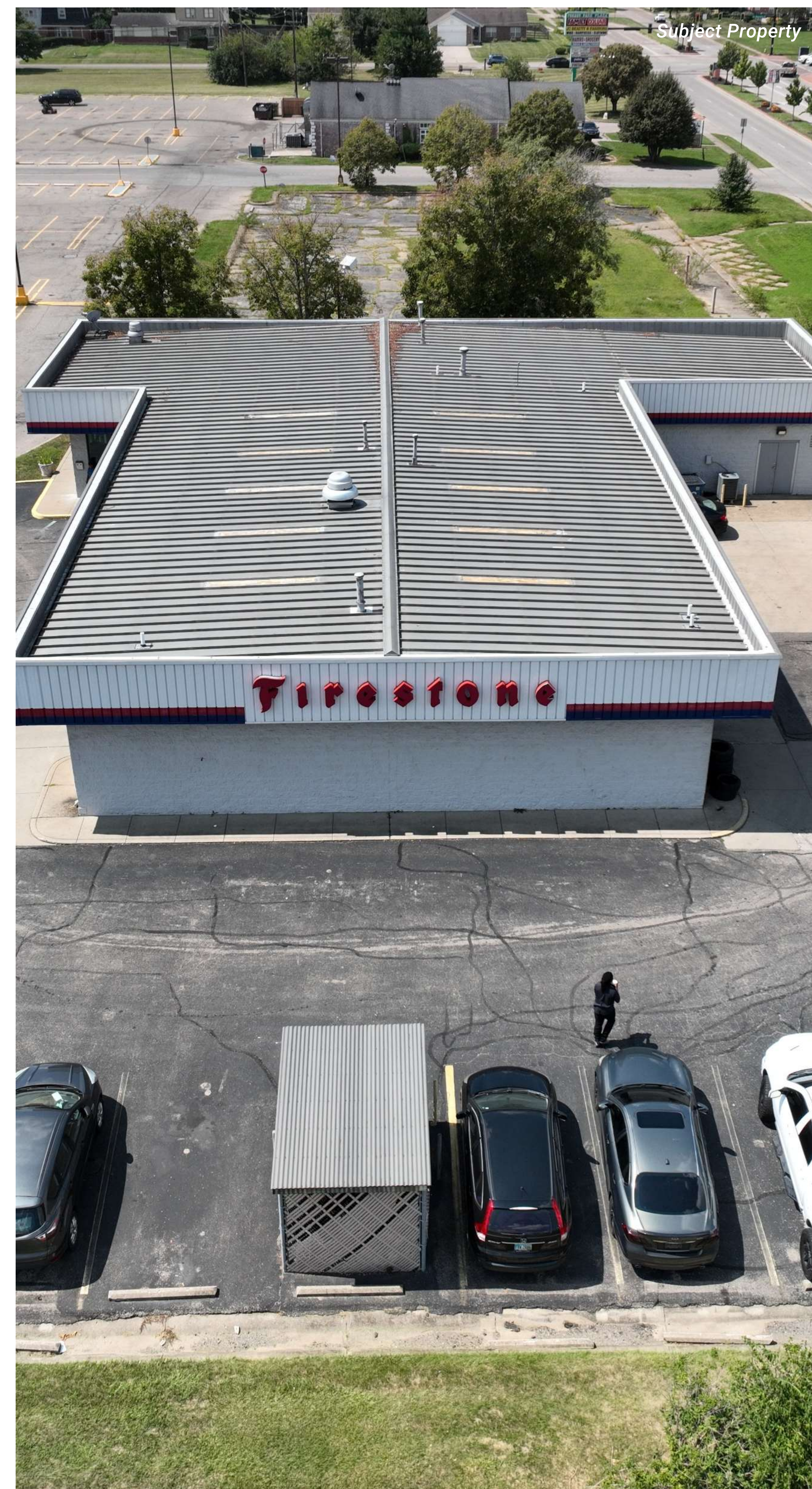

These locations provide a comprehensive range of **vehicle-maintenance** and repair services, including tire replacement, alignments, brakes, batteries, oil changes, diagnostics, heating and cooling services, and other automotive repairs. Firestone's heritage **dates to 1900**, when Harvey S. Firestone founded the Firestone Tire & Rubber Company in Akron, Ohio. The Cincinnati metro area is a 15-county region located within portions of Ohio, Kentucky and Indiana that maintains a population of 2.31 million in total. Known as the "Queen City."

Cincinnati is the third largest city in Ohio and the 29th largest city in the United States.

The city is home to the headquarters of several major companies including The Kroger Company, Procter & Gamble, Fifth Third Bank and the E.W. Scripps Company and is one of the fastest growing cities in the Midwest.

The accessibility combined with Cincinnati's top ranked business climate has made it a choice location for businesses.

Greater Cincinnati is one of the most strategically located metropolitan regions in the country for access by manufacturing and service industries. Air, highway, river and rail transportation give Cincinnati ready access within 600 miles of 53% of the nation's manufacturing establishments. Three interstate highway systems (I-75, I-74 and I-71) and two interstate connectors (I-275 and I-471) service the Cincinnati region and provide access to all geographic directions. Fourteen major universities are located within 100 miles of Cincinnati with a combined undergraduate enrollment of over 200,000 students. The thriving business community has created a strong demand for talent within the top programs at schools within the region.

KDM Signs Expands Cincinnati Operations, Creating 121 New Jobs

AUGUST 24, 2026 (JOBSSOHIO)

KDM Signs is expanding its Cincinnati operations, creating 121 new jobs and \$6.1 million in new annual payroll as it establishes Cincinnati as a center of excellence for its North American operations.

The print, retail-marketing and in-store-solutions provider will expand capabilities in store décor, acrylic displays, fulfillment, distribution and campaign execution. The Cincinnati operation will serve as an important hub for KDM’s growing North American business, building on the region’s logistics connectivity, skilled workforce and longstanding printing-industry base. The project increases KDM’s local workforce by more than 90% and reinforces the region’s value proposition for advanced manufacturing, business services and distribution-oriented users.

Cincinnati Secures Federal Funding for Fort Washington Way Project

JULY 1, 2026 (WCPO 9)

Cincinnati secured \$25 million in federal funding for a proposed cap and public plaza over Fort Washington Way in the riverfront district.

The initial project phase would construct an approximately 1.2-acre highway cap and public plaza over the eight-lane I-71/U.S. Route 50 corridor. The investment is intended to reconnect neighborhoods separated by the highway, expand public green space and create opportunities for events, recreation and adjacent economic development. By improving pedestrian connectivity between downtown and the riverfront, the project advances a long-range placemaking strategy around one of Cincinnati’s highest-profile urban districts.

Resilience and Lilly Invest \$750 Million to Increase U.S. Manufactured Medicine Supply

JULY 30, 2026 (JOBSSOHIO)

Resilience and Eli Lilly are investing \$750 million to expand advanced pharmaceutical manufacturing in the Cincinnati region and create at least 400 new high-skilled jobs.

The expansion will add Lilly KwikPen injectable-device production for diabetes and obesity medicines at Resilience’s Cincinnati-area operations. Site preparation is underway, with full operations anticipated in early 2027. Resilience operates two advanced regional facilities totaling nearly 1 million square feet and employs nearly 1,000 people locally; the investment will bring its Ohio-created job total above 1,400. The project strengthens Greater Cincinnati’s life-sciences cluster and provides a significant pipeline of high-wage manufacturing employment.

Ohio Mixed-Use Projects Expected to Spur \$1.3 Billion in Community Investments

JULY 1, 2026 (SPECTRUM NEWS 1)

Ohio awarded support for 13 mixed-use projects expected to create more than \$318 million in payroll and \$1.3 billion in investment, including the reimagining of Cincinnati’s 4th and Walnut Center.

The Transformational Mixed-Use Development Program committed more than \$110 million in state support across 10 communities. Cincinnati’s 4th and Walnut Center is among the funded redevelopment projects, positioning an important downtown site for reinvestment. The program is structured to support developments that combine complementary uses and return underutilized real estate to productive use. State participation adds momentum to Cincinnati’s urban redevelopment pipeline and supports downtown demand drivers including housing, employment, hospitality and retail activity.

Beehive Industries to Expand in Southwest Ohio, Creating More Than 200 Jobs

JULY 21, 2026 (JOBSSOHIO)

Beehive Industries plans to expand its Southwest Ohio operations, creating more than 200 jobs and investing \$70 million to scale production of additively manufactured jet engines.

The company designs advanced 3D-printed propulsion systems for uncrewed aerial defense applications and is accelerating production in Southwest Ohio. Beehive recently acquired two Greater Cincinnati precision-machine shops, Able Tool Corporation and Planet Products Corporation, to establish a production-machining center of excellence. Together with a major expansion of its metal additive-manufacturing capacity, these investments position the regional operation to support production of more than 8,000 engines annually, reinforcing Cincinnati’s aerospace and precision-manufacturing base.

Mitsubishi Electric Selects Mason for New International Investment

JULY 27, 2026 (CINCINNATI BUSINESS COURIER)

Mitsubishi Electric’s U.S. heating and air-conditioning subsidiary selected its Greater Cincinnati campus in Mason for a new company expected to create 180 jobs.

The expansion brings a new international investment to the Cincinnati region and further strengthens Mason’s position as a corporate and advanced-manufacturing employment center. The project is supported by Ohio tax credits and local grants, reflecting regional commitment to job creation and business retention. The additional employment supports daytime population and consumer demand in the I-71 corridor, one of Greater Cincinnati’s principal suburban commercial nodes.

Cincinnati Breaks Ground on \$540M Marriott Downtown Hotel

JULY 21, 2026 (CITYBEAT)

Cincinnati officials and development partners broke ground on the \$540 million Cincinnati Marriott Downtown, a centerpiece of the city’s \$828 million Convention District revitalization plan.

The downtown project will deliver a 700-room full-service hotel connected by skybridge to the renovated First Financial Center. Plans include 60,000 square feet of meeting space, a 17,000-square-foot events terrace, multiple ballrooms, restaurant and ground-floor retail. Scheduled for completion in 2028, the hotel is designed to enhance Cincinnati’s capacity to attract conventions, business travel and leisure visitors. Its scale creates a major long-term hospitality and visitor-economy anchor in the downtown core.

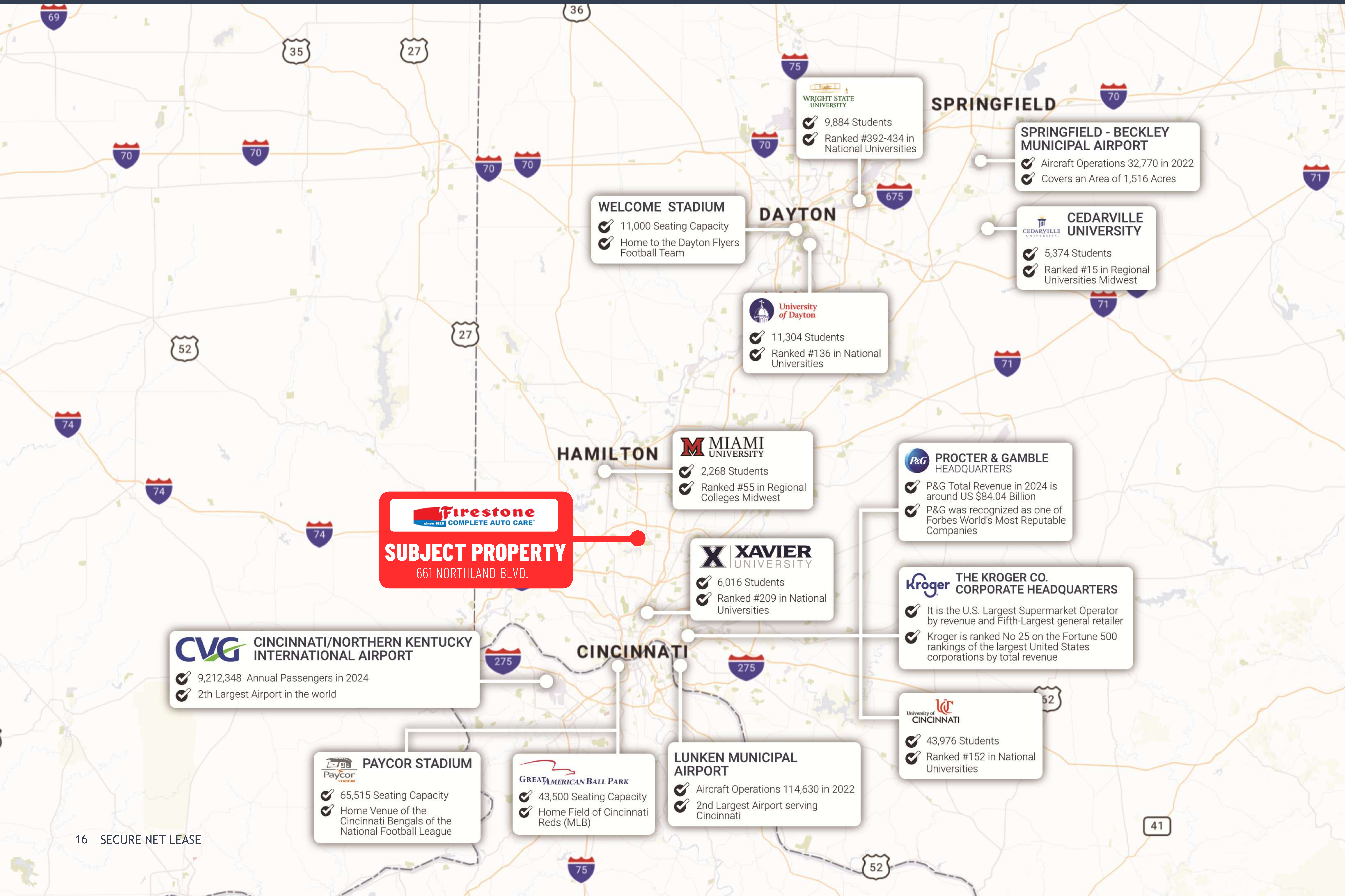
AtriCure received a \$6 million REDI Cincinnati grant to support a \$45 million Mason headquarters expansion projected to create 400 jobs.

The medical-device company’s planned 120,000-square-foot expansion will provide additional laboratory, research-and-development, office and advanced-manufacturing space. The project is expected to add 400 positions at an average salary of \$137,500, creating a substantial high-wage employment catalyst in the Mason submarket. It also reinforces Greater Cincinnati’s depth in health-care innovation and specialized manufacturing while supporting ongoing commercial demand along the I-71 employment corridor.
