
LOCATION

Attenborough House is located in the busy commercial area surrounding Bennet Road, it is just two miles south of Reading Town Centre. The recently redeveloped site at Reading Gateway provides additional amenity to the existing restaurants and supermarkets in the surrounding area.

Reading is recognised as the 'capital' of the Thames Valley and is an established commercial location with excellent road and public transport links. Attenborough House is located just off the A322 which is one of the major arterial roads leading from Reading town centre to the M4.
